



Abigail Rose is a smaller dwarf version of Higasayama. Spring growth is a cloud of small pink and cream leaves fading to cream and green in summer. It is similar to Shin hikasa but smaller in stature. It is probably best considered a collectors plant. Fall color is orange and pink.





Adrian's Compact is a pretty, dwarf red maple. The summer color is more red than purple, and its leaves appear to glow in direct light. The fall color is a strong red. Adrian's Compact matures in size to around 5' by 5', and it has larger leaves and a more open structure than Shaina.





Aka kawa hime is a dwarf coral bark maple that is slower growing than Fjellheim or Winter Flame. Its habit is teardrop in shape, growing to be a plant that is as wide as it is tall. This makes it an excellent plant for confined spaces where the plant needs to remain small. (Small red bark)

Akaji nishiki is probably the true name of the plant know as Bonfire. It is a slow growing palmatum to about 5'. Leaves are orange and pink, fading to a mottled green in the heat of the summer. Fall color is an excellent bright red. Seigen is possibly the same variety.








Akane is a slower growing dwarf in the Katsura group. Spring color is a bright orange, brighter and longer lasting than Katsura. It will probably be only 3 by 3' at maturity. Fall color is a brief yellow and red. (Madder plant, Glowing evening sky)





Akita yatsubusa is a true dwarf palmatum that is similar in appearance to Sharps Pygmy. Its twigs are brown and its leaves are larger than those of Sharps Pygmy. Akita yatsubusa has good orange red fall color. At maturity, this dwarf will reach 4' by 4'.





Allyn Cook is a semi dwarf A. circinatum to about 6', taller than wide. Spring color is a lime green maturing to a medium green. Fall color is bronze.





<u>Amagi shigure</u> is a red reticulated leafed palmatum of shorter stature. Spring color is a brilliant orange red with distinctive dark veins, fading to a pink red in summer. Fall color is scarlet. (Soft drizzle)



Amagi is a bush Japanese maple, more upright and faster growing than the similar Tama hime. Mature size will be about 6' by 6'. It should not be confused with the variegated upright Amagi shigure.





<u>Anna's Broom</u> is a red witch's broom similar in size to Shaina. Mature height will be in the 2' range. Mature foliage fades to green, with new growth giving the plant a two toned effect.







Anne Irene is a beautiful witches' broom from Summer Gold. Mature height is unknown but probably under 5'. Spring color is a bright orange maturing to a lasting gold. Fall color is yellow and orange. It has great economic potential.





Aoba jo is strong growing green dwarf that forms a round ball-like shape. Its leaves are surprisingly large for a dwarf palmatum. At maturity, this dwarf will reach 5' by 5'. It is popular for bonsai.

Aoyagi gawa is a small growing linearlobum similar to Koto no ito. It is noted for it's yellow fall color and yellow green winter bark. It will probably mature at about 10', taller than wide.







<u>Aratama</u> is a red dwarf Japanese maple of smaller structure. Its older leaves become green in the summer. It is an excellent plant for a patio use, and has lovely garnet fall color. (Uncut gem)





<u>Aureum</u> is a small, semi-dwarf Acer shirawanum known for its brilliant golden foliage. Seldom more than ten feet in height, Aureum does best with afternoon shade. Aureum is a highly desirable plant in the landscape. Its fall color is a beautiful orange and red.

<u>Baby Buttons</u> is a small green leaved dwarf A. circinatum forming a round bun. It is probably a witches broom. Mature size is unknown, but probably under 3 feet.





<u>Baby Dragon</u> is a dwarf A. truncatum from Metro Maple in Ft. Worth. Thin branching give this plant a weeping bushy habit. Mature height is unknown but probably under 5'. Fall color is yellow and red.







Bashful is a pretty dwarf A. shirasawanum. Mature height and width are unknown, but probably under 3'. Spring color can have variegation as the leaf emerges. Fall color is orange and red.





<u>Beni Chaparito</u> is a dwarf red palmatum with deeply divided leaves. Mature height is about 8'. Fall color is a bright Crimson. It is possibly the original Pixie. (Red Dwarf in Hino Spanglish)





Beni fushigi is a dwarf maple with intense red, deeply cut and twisted leaves. It has similar coloration to Shindeshojo –starting bright red and fading to a mottled green. Beni fushigi ends with its strong red fall color. (Red wonder or Red mystery)





<u>Beni hime</u> is one of the smallest maple dwarfs. Spring color is bright orange red fading to red green in the summer. It is somewhat delicate and is probably best suited for use as a patio pot. Fall color is red. (Red dwarf)





Beni hoshi is a dwarf maple with red star shaped leaves, fading to green in the heat of the summer. New red growth gives the plant a two toned look. Mature size will be about 5' by 5'. Fall color is yellow to orange. (Red star)







Beni komachi is a dwarf plant similar to Beni fushigi, but it is slower growing. It has brilliant red, twisted leaves in the spring, and is perfect for smaller spaces. Beni komachi reaches only 3' by 4' at maturity. (The red beautiful girl)





<u>Beni kosade</u> is a excellent dwarf palmatum. Spring color is a bright salmon pink, fading to a variegated green and pink. It is rather delicate, and should be considered a collector plant.

Beni Mikawa is a seedling from Mikawa yatsubusa. Spring foliage is an orange red. It soon fades to an creamy yellow and then to a light green. It would be best grown in partial shade. It is not very hardy and should be considered a collectors plant.





Beni shi en compact is a slightly smaller growing version of Beni shi en.

New growth has subtle cream Butterflylike variegation on the leaf
margins. Summer color is a plum purple. Mature height is unknown. Fall
color is orange. (Compact red smoke)





Beni ubi gohan is a compact semi-dwarf plant with red leaves. The color fades gently in the summer to echo the color shades of Oshio beni. At maturity, Beni ubi gohan reaches only 5' by 5'. This has wonderful potential as a bonsai. (Red refined rice)





<u>Beni zuru</u> is an attractive dwarf with outstanding orange pink spring foliage. Summer color is a medium green. Mature height is unknown, but likely under 5'. Fall color is a bright crimson. (Red swan)








Berry Dwarf is a flat growing dwarf, taller than kiyohime yatsubusa. Leaves are a medium green. Fall color is yellow orange and red. At maturity it will be about 4' tall by 10' wide.





<u>Bonfire</u> is a beautiful dwarf maple with iridescent spring foliage. It is delicate grower, but worth the effort. Mature is size is around 8' tall. Bonfire is a California favorite.





<u>Brandts Dwarf</u> is a bush Japanese maple that fills the function of Shaina, but is a much better grower. It has red fall foliage. At maturity, it is around 5' by 5'. Brandts Dwarf is an underused gem in the landscape.





<u>Briella's Broom</u> is a red witches broom, more vigorous than Shaina. Mature height is unknown, but probably in the 4' range.





<u>Calico</u> is a bushy semi-dwarf maple in the Katsura group. Spring foliage is orange fading to a light green. Mature height is in the 8 to 10 foot range, as wide as tall. Fall color is good orange and red.





<u>Caperci Dwarf</u> is a horizontal-growing dwarf maple similar to Kiyohime yatsubusa. Its spring growth is a light pink in color. In 10 years it will grow to 8' wide by 4' high.





<u>Carlis Corner</u> is a red witch's broom dwarf similar to Shaina. It will grow as a ball to about 3'. Fall color is red with pink high lights.



Chiri hime is a small growing maple with leaves held in clusters . Leaves are deeply dissected. Fall color is a bright orange and red. Mature height is unknown, but probably under 10'.





Coonara Pygmy is a green witches' broom dwarf maple. Its spring growth is orange in color; its fall color is orange to red. It forms a round ball that is more upright than the similar Tama hime or Kiyohime yatsubusa.





<u>Corallinum</u> is a dwarf version of Shindeshojo . It has outstanding florescent pink new growth that fades to green with 'sand flecks' variegation in the heat of the summer. An old specimen barely reaches 4' by 4'. This plant needs some frost protection.






<u>Corvallis Broom</u> is a dwarf small leave green palmatum. Spring growth is pinkish maturing to a yellow green. Fall color is orange and red. Mature size in unknown, but probably under 5'.





Curtis' Strapleaf an old variety, plum purple in the spring. Fall color is a bright orange. it will form a small tree to about 10', wider than tall. Leaves are deeply cut and have more three lobed leaves than the other linearlobum types.







<u>Cynthia's Crown jewel</u> is a smaller green dwarf palmatum. Leaves are deeply cut with a red tinge to the new growth. Fall color is orange and red. It will grow to a flat bush around 4', wider than tall.






<u>Del's Dwarf sieboldianum</u> is a compact A. sieboldianum with outstanding pink spring growth. Mature height is unknown but probably under 10'. Fall foliage is a deep red.





<u>Del's Dwarf</u> is a dwarf circinatum maple with gorgeous peach spring and early summer growth. The branching is airy and twisted giving the plant a unique structure. The leaves transition to a peasing orange and red color in the fall. It can grow to be 5' wide by 4' tall in ten years.







Diana is a green dwarf palmatum with reddish pink new growth. It will form a round bush to about 5 feet. Fall color is orange red.






<u>Dr. Seuss</u> is a dwarf example of the Butterfly Japanese maple. The new foliage is orange-red in color, while the summer color is a medium green. The fall color is orange to red. The name, Dr. Seuss, fits the whimsy of the plant's structure, and has strong commercial appeal.





<u>Elizabeth</u> is a red witches' broom maple that is similar to Brandts Dwarf in coloring with its pleasing red fall color. Elizabeth forms an attractive columnar dwarf that is unique in the Japanese maple world. At maturity, it should be around 6' tall by 3' wide.





Englishtown is a red dwarf maple with tiny secondary leaves. It grows in a teardrop form with the appearance of a red Hanami nishiki. Englishtown holds its color well in the heat of the summer and will reach 5' by 5' at maturity. Fall color is a vivid red.





Enkan is a red linearlobum dwarf Japanese maple. It is similar to Villa taranto in habit, but is a slower grower and more horizontal in its branch structure. Enkan holds its deep red color all summer. Fall color is red.







<u>Fairy Hair</u> is a tiny dwarf maple with extremely thin hair like leaves. It is surprisingly hardy and can be grown in the landscape. Mature size will seldom exceed 1'. Fall color is orange and red.







Fantastico is a pretty green dwarf Japanese maple to about 6'. Fall color is a nice orange red.






<u>F.H. Sister</u> is a sister seedling to Fairy Hair. Foliage, growth rate and mature size are slightly larger than Fairy Hair. Fall color is a nice orange.





<u>Filifera purperea</u> has color changes throughout the season similar to those of the Villa Taranto, but is much better grower. It has up to seven colors in a years time. Filifera purperea can grow to 10' at maturity



<u>Filiformis</u> is a new A. shirasawanum variety similar to Aureum. Only time will tell if it can be field grown with out burning. Spring color is a soft yellow cream maturing to a good yellow green. Fall color is orange and red. Mature height is unknown.




<u>Fireball</u> is a tight red witches' broom of a Japanese maple. The plant is almost identical in appearance to Shaina, but has even smaller and has more congested leaves. Fireball has deep red fall color.





Fjellheim is a witches' broom from Sango kaku. It retains all the characteristics of its parent, beautiful coral branches and lime green leaves, but it forms a compact bush taller than wide. The fall color is a Sango kaku orange.





Fukinagashi is a dwarf maple new from Japan with twisted, deeply divided leaves. Spring growth is yellow orange, maturing to a deep green. The heat of summer brings a deep red to the leaf. Mature height is unknown, but probably an open bush to about 5'. Fall color is red. The plant is somewhat delicate and should be considered a collectors plant.







<u>Gaki no sugi</u> is a semi dwarf bush to around 6'. Spring color is a cream white with green venation. Fall color is a bright red.





<u>Garyu</u> is a trailing dwarf maple, new growth tipped with orange. Fall color is red. It will grow in a mass to about 1' tall by 2' wide. This plant is delicate and should be considered a collector plant.

Geisha is a gorgeous variegated pink dwarf, seldom exceeding 2' in height. Foliage is a mix of white pink and green pastel blotches. Geisha is somewhat delicate and is probably best suited for use as a patio plant.





<u>Glen- Del</u> is a dwarf upright Acer circinatum with every leaf different from the next. Color varies by leaf, from cream and green to purple. It is not a strong grower, so mature height will be in the 8' range.





Goshiki kotohime is similar to Shishigashira in habit, but is more of a dwarf. It can have beautiful pink and white variegation on its second growth. It is one of the first maples to leaf out in the spring, so it will need frost protection. (Dwarf old harp)





Green Trompenburg is a similar plant to Trompenburg, but it is a much smaller grower. The leaves are a deep green with the leaf lobes that curl under. The fall color is yellow and garnet. It will mature to a large bush to about 8'.





<u>Ground Cover</u> is a small leaved dwarf maple that is named for its ability to hug the ground. At maturity, it will reach only 1' in height, 3' in diameter. It is excellent for use in rock gardens and hardscapes.

<u>Hana fubuki</u> is a smaller growing butterfly type with outstanding pink spring growth. Mature height is unknown, but Hana fubuki appears to be a dwarf. Fall color is pinkish red.





Hana tsukasa is delicate dwarf variegated palmatum. Spring coloration is pink soon becoming almost white. Partial shade is recommended for this beautiful variety and it is probably best thought of as a collector plant.





<u>Hanami nishiki</u> is a green dwarf maple with thumbnail-sized palmatum leaves and even smaller secondary leaves. It forms a tight, bush-like shape that is perfect for bonsai or as a patio plant. (Flower viewing for the season of cherry blossom)





<u>Haru iro</u> is a semi dwarf A. shirasawanum. Spring foliage is a plum red with light green veins. It could be considered a dwarf version of Johin. Fall color is yellow. (Spring color)

<u>Hatzu shigare</u> is a horizontal dwarf palmatum, taller than wide. Spring color is pink soon fading to green.





<u>Higasayama Broom</u> is a dwarf witches broom from Higasayama. It retains the traits of the parent but in a much more dwarf form. Second year wood has the leaf edging of red and white variegation. New growth is palmatum green, and has orange red fall color. Mature size is unknown but it will be a smaller dwarf.






<u>Higasayama nishiki</u> is a dwarf broom from Higasayama. At this age it appears identical to Higasayama Broom. Mature height is unknown but this will be a small dwarf.





<u>Hime shojo</u> is an excellent red dwarf palmatum. Foliage is more red than purple. The plant is more upright than spreading. Mature height is unknown, but probably under 6'. Fall color is a bright scarlet.





<u>Hoshi kuzu</u> is a variegated dwarf palmatum. Foliage is green and cream with sickle shaped lobes reminiscent of Butterfly. It will form a round ball to about 6'. Fall color is orange.





<u>Hupps Dwarf</u> is a compact green dwarf maple. It is slow growing but upright. Fall color is orange. The mature size is around 5', and it is taller than it is wide. Hupps dwarf is suitable for bonsai.





<u>lbo juhi</u> is a dwarf version of Pine bark maple. The rough bark starts to form on third year wood, new foliage is orange. It will grow in a teardrop shape to about 3'. Fall color is orange.





<u>In The Pink</u> is a dwarf palmatum with pink new growth. Foliage fades to a deep green in summer. Fall color is orange and red. It will grow to a ball around 6' by 6'.



<u>Japanese Princess</u> is a pleasing green dwarf with overlapping green leaves. It is a more dwarf version of Mikawa yatsubusa. Spring growth is a yellow orange. It will probably be only 2 by 2' in ten years. Fall color is an orange red.





Jerre Schwartz is an attractive dwarf witches broom with small deeply divided leaves. Spring color is a pink red, maturing to a purple red. Summer color fades to a reddish green. Mature height is unknown, but probably under 4'. Fall color is a bright red.





Jim's memory is a new A. palmatum named after the late, great Jim Schmidt. It was developed by Bob McCaffery of Alpine Nursery. We have little information on height, and width, but it appears to be a large bush similar to Englishtown in form.









<u>Jordan</u> is a beautiful new A. shirasawanum with yellow white foliage. Very attractive plant, but subject to burn. Mature height and width are unknown. Fall color is orange and red.





<u>Kamagata</u> is a dwarf maple of delicate appearance with leaf lobes that curl gently upwards. New leaves are green with purple edges. The fall color is an excellent red. It is one of the larger dwarfs, growing up to 10' in height. (Sickle shaped)





Kandy Kitchen is a red dwarf maple in the style of Shaina and Fireball. The older leaves fade to green, giving the plant a two-toned effect with its second growth. The fall color is a garnet red. At maturity its size is only 3' by 3'.





 $\underline{\text{Kashima}}$ is the smallest and slowest growing of the flat, bush dwarf maples. It is widely used for bonsai as it grows to be only 3' wide in ten years.





Katja is a spreading bush to about 8 feet. Spring foliage is a soft yellow with red margins. Leaves soon mature to a deep green. Fall color is a garnet red.





<u>Katura hime</u> is a vigorous dwarf version of Katsura. Like Katsura it is a bright orange in the spring. Color fades to yellow and then to green. Fall color is a good orange and red. Mature height is unknown, but it will be a large dwarf or small tree.





<u>Katsura nishiki</u> is a variegated plant with spring growth from white to a pinkish orange and red.. Summer color is green with subtle blotches of cream. Mature height is unknown, but this is not a vigorous plant, Fall color is a deep red.





Kevin's Dwarf Sango is a dwarf Sango Kaku found by Kevin Kelley. It has all the characteristics of Sango but in a much smaller size. Ultimate size is unknown. Cold hardiness is unknown.







<u>King George Broom</u> is a witches' broom found in New Jersey. Spring color is a pleasing cherry red. It Will probably be similar in habit and size to Shaina. Fall color is a garnet red.






<u>Kinshi</u> is a green dwarf palmatum with thin, strap-like leaves. It is a similar plant to Koto no ito, but its summer foliage is a deeper green. The fall foliage is a bright orange. It will grow to around 8' at maturity. (Golden Thread)

<u>Kiyohime</u> one of the earliest dwarf maple found in the garden. It should not to be confused with Kiyohime yatsubusa, a flat growing dwarf. It adds structure to a garden; and will mature to around 10'. Fall color is yellow, orange and red. It is an underused jewel.





<u>Kobo shojo</u> is a small shrub with star shaped leaves. Leaf color is similar to Chitoseyama: red in spring, orange red and then green in summer. Fall color is an excellent scarlet.





Komachi hime is a fast-growing, green dwarf maple similar in habit to Shishiohime, but even larger in size. New growth is an orange-red giving a two-toned effect. Its mature size can be up to 12' wide by 6' tall.





Koto maru is a green witches' broom dwarf maple with penny sized leaves. New growth is a yellow orange that turns to a deep green as the leaf matures. Koto maru forms a compact and slow growing dwarf to about 2' tall. (Round harp)





<u>Koto no ito</u> is green, dwarf linearlobum upright with very thread-like leaves. Its fall color is an excellent orange. Koto no ito is one of the larger growing dwarfs, reaching up to 12' in height. (Harp strings)





<u>Kotohime</u> is a dwarf palmatum with tiny leaves New foliage is reddish orange quickly fading to a medium green. Leaves are even smaller than the related Goshiki kotohime. Mature height probably will be under 4'. Fall color is a dark red.





<u>Kristen's Star</u> is a compact dwarf maple with outstanding bright orange red spring growth. It is like A.p. Akane, but actually grows. Summer foliage is a chartreuse green with bright orange red fall color. Mature height will probably be in the 8 'to 10' range











<u>Kurui jishi</u> is a dwarf version of Okushimo. Its leaf lobes curl upward to give a star-shaped appearance. It has wonderful golden fall foliage. (A confused lion)





<u>Lily Pad</u> is a variegated bud sport from Mikawa yatsubusa. Variegation is more prominent is spring and fall. It will be a flat growing shrub, mature size unknown.







<u>Lima Gold</u> is a small leafed dwarf similar in size and leaf to Hanami nishiki. Leaves are the size of a thumbnail, but are lime green in color. Fall color is a yellow gold.





<u>Little Fella</u> is a small growing reddish A. shirasawanum with rolled leaves. It has the appearance of a small Trompenburg. Height and width are unknown, but probably semi dwarf in stature.







<u>Little Fingers</u> is another small linearlobum form of palmatum. New growth is pink fading to a medium green. Fall color is un known. Height and width unknown, but it will be taller than wide.





<u>Little Gem</u> is a dwarf Acer circinatum that forms a tight, round ball. Its summer foliage is a light green with orange and crimson fall foliage. Its mature size is around 6' by 6'.



<u>Lille Red</u> is a small growing maple, semi columnar in structure. Mature height and structure is unknown, but it will be a dwarf. It is said to be a smaller version of Skeeter's Broom.







<u>Livy</u> is a newer red dwarf, probably maturing to the 6 to 8' size. Leaf size is larger than most dwarfs and seem to hold red color well in heat of summer. Fall color is a bright crimson.





The true name of this dwarf maple is not known. It is not the <u>Marakumo</u>, a variegated upright seen in literature. It is however, a pleasing round maple that will grow to be 4' by 4' in ten years.







Marlo is a beautiful semi dwarf variegated Japanese maple, upright in form. Mature height is unknown, but probably in the 6' range.





Matthew is a reliable dwarf maple with yellowish green leaves. The leaves become brighter as the summer progresses, and finally transition to a beautiful orange fall color. Matthew will reach 4' by 4' in ten years.







<u>Mayday</u> is a dwarf palmatum seedling from Mikawa yatsubusa. Spring color is a bright pink, fading to green with cream markings on leaf edges. Mature height and spread are unknown.





Mendocino Sunrise is a sport from Summer Gold with small yellow leaves. Leaves frequently have a orange blush and ruffled appearance The plant is a dense upright grower, mature height unknown.



Mikawa nishiki is a variegated seedling from Mikawa yatsubusa. Form is similar to the parent but with longer internodes. Variegation can be scarce, when present It has maroon over light green foliage in the spring. Fall color is a bright orange to red. Some afternoon shade is recommended for this variety





Mikawa yatsubusa is an excellent green dwarf with leaves that overlap like shingles on a roof. It grows in an irregular shape with some branches growing more vigorously than others, giving the plant a distinctive alien-like appearance. Mikawa yatsubusa's fall color is orange and red. (Three rivers)





Mino yatsubusa is a dwarf A. buergerianum forming a rounded bush to about 6'. Leaves have three narrow pointed lobes; the middle lobe longer than the rest. New growth is a reddish green soon fading to a deep green. Fall color is orange and red.



Miwa is a small growing palmatum with subtle green venation on a light green leaf. Spring foliage can be yellow. Mature height is unknown, but probably under 10'. Fall color is an excellent yellow orange and red. (Graceful beauty)







Mikasayama yatsubusa is a beautiful dwarf A. buergerianum. Leaf lobes are triangular and bright green with reddish new growth. It grows as an upright ball to about 5'. Fall color is yellow gold. (Dwarf Prince)





Mr. Sun is a slower growing Acer shirasawanum with deeply divided bright green leaves, leaf lobes curling under. The entire plant is bright green; leaves, twigs, and branches. Ultimate height is unknown but probably under 10'. Fall color is a great yellow and orange.







Murasaki kiyohime is a flat-growing dwarf maple that is wider than it is tall. The foliage is a deep green with purple tips on new growth. Fall color is a deep red. Murasaki kiyohime is a flatter version of Shishiohime.







Novolischi is an interesting A. platanoides, dwarf in stature. It's sharply cut leaves and coloration give the appearance of a holly. Mature size and fall color are unknown.





O jishi is the male version of the female Shishigashira. It is a slower and smaller grower than Shishigashira. Leaves are more open and twisted. Fall color is a nice orange and red. It is not common in the trade.





Ogi Tsuma gaki is a semi dwarf version of Tsuma gaki. That is, having yellow green spring growth tipped in red. Leaves are more round than Tsuma gaki and it will grow to be around 8'.tall. Fall color is gold to scarlet.







Okina is a thin branched dwarf palmatum. New growth is a pinkish red, fading to green in summer. Leaves are deeply divided and narrow. It can be compared to Kamagata, but it is slower growing and more horizontal. Fall color is a deep red. (Old Man)





Oku kuji nishiki is the dwarf version of Butterfly. It has the scallopedshaped variegation, and the branching of Butterfly, but it will only reach around 6'. Fall color is a bright pink purple.





Olson's Frosted Strawberry is a smaller growing member of the Aka shigitatsu sawa group. Spring color is a bright pink with noticeable dark veins. Summer brings almost white foliage with green veins. Mature height is unknown. Fall color is red.






<u>Oregon Sunset</u> is a Bloodgood-red dwarf maple that holds its color throughout the summer. The fall foliage is a garnet red. Oregon Sunset can take the place of a laceleaf in the in the landscape.







Orion is a red dwarf with deeply divided leaves, but not as divided as the cultivar Jerre Schwartz. Orion fades to a dull green in summer. Mature size is unknown, but it will be a bigger, more open plant than Shaina.



Otaha is a fine red dwarf similar to beni hime, but faster growing. Red spring foliage fades to medium green as leaf matures. Growth is tight and congested and mature height will probably not exceed 2'. Fall color is a deep red.





Oto hime is a vigorous flat top bush more compact than Kamagata. Spring growth is yellow green turning a bright green as the leaf matures. Oto hime remains compact with little training, probably growing to not over 6' in height. (Mythical queen of the ocean)





<u>Patsy</u> is a semi dwarf Japanese maple with bright yellow green Foliage. New growth is edged with a distinctive purple red. Mature height is unknown, but probably in the 10' range. Fall color is an excellent yellow and orange.







<u>Peve Dave</u> is a dwarf red upright with leaves that approach that of a linearlobum. Autumn color is a bright orange and red. Mature height and width is unknown.







<u>Peve Ollie</u> is a compact semi dwarf tree with red twisted leaves. Thick trunk and sturdy branches would make this variety useful for bonsai. Spring color is crimson fading to purple. Fall color is orange to red.







<u>Pung kil</u> in a red dwarf palmatum with linearlobum leaves from Korea. Spring growth is a light red, darkening as the leaf matures. It retains a deep plum color in the heat of summer. Mature height is unknown. Fall color is a garnet red.






<u>Pygmy</u> is a flat-growing dwarf maple which is slower growing than Kiyohime yatsubusa. The new growth is yellow-green that changes to a medium green as the leaf matures. It will reach 5' wide by 2' tall in ten years.





Red Crusader is a dwarf red Japanese maple with small deeply cut leaves. Mature height is unknown, but probably under 10', taller than wide. Fall color is orange red.





Red Pygmy is a dwarf maple with fine linear lobes. It is red in the spring, fading to green, and then finally to a straw gold by summer. The fall color is orange-red. The mature height can exceed 12'.

Red Wine is an upright bushy shrub to about 6'. Leaves are bronze red in the spring, fading to green with red tips. Fall color is a great orange red.







Rhode Island Red is an excellent red dwarf, fading to red green in the heat of summer. It will form a globe to about 5' in diameter. Fall color is scarlet.





Royale is red witches broom dwarf. Spring growth is a pinkish red, maturing to purple red. It will grow to about 5', taller than wide. Fall color is scarlet.





Ruby Stars is the same scion as Beni hoshi. According to Del Loukes, the originator of the plant, the new name was created when he gave the plant to Harry Olsen who misremembered the name. Fall color is orange and red.







Ryoku ryu is a dwarf green maple with pinkish spring color. It will form an upright bush to about 6', taller than wide. Fall color is orange and red. (Green Rain)





Ryu gu is an excellent variegated dwarf. Leaves are a medium green with white and pink spots on red twigs. Mature height is unknown.


Autumn color is a bright red. (Dragon Palace)





Ryu sen is a cascading, green Japanese maple. The growth rate is rapid, so Ryu sen is beautiful in a pot, as a ground cover, or as a top grafted specimen. The fall foliage is a strong orange-red. (Falling stars)





Ryuzu is a compact slow growing bush palmatum, holding its leaves on the branch tips. This gives the plant a unique open airy look. New growth is pink, fading to green. It will grow to about 5' by 5'. Fall color is a nice orange. (Ornamental dragon head)





<u>Saiho</u> is a green dwarf Japanese maple with red on the tips of the new growth. It is named for the famous moss garden in Kyoto. Mature height and width are unknown.







<u>Sara D</u> is a witches' broom red dwarf maple similar to Shaina. It is more vigorous than Shaina in growth and forms a larger bush. The fall color is a nice red. It can achieve 3' by 3' in ten years.





<u>Seigen</u> is a slow growing upright bush to about 8'. Crimson new growth fades to a mottled green in summer. It is probably the original name for the plant A. palmatum Bonfire. It is a California favorite. Fall color is fire engine red.





<u>Seiun Kaku</u> is a flat topped shrub similar to Mikawa yatsubusa, but more open growing. Leaves overlap like shingles on a house. It is a larger bush than Mikawa yatsubusa and will grow to about 8' tall by 10' wide. Fall color is a bright orange red.







Shaina is a witches' broom from Bloodgood with congested, red foliage. The center lobe of the leaf is shortened which is typical of a witches' broom. Shaina has pleasing crimson fall color, and is excellent for bonsai.





<u>Sharps Pygmy</u> is a compact, green dwarf maple with small leaves that forms a miniature tree. The fall color is orange to scarlet, and it is excellent for bonsai. Sharps Pygmy will form a 5' by 5' bush in forty years.





<u>Shidava Gold</u> is a dwarf version of Ukon or Aoyagi. It has bright green leaves and pea green bark. The fall color is a clear yellow. The mature size may only reach 5' by 5'.







<u>Shigi no hoshi</u> is a dense dwarf shrub with small leaves. The leaves are cream yellow with green veins in the spring. Mature height is unknown, but probably under 5'. Fall color is a butter yellow.








Shigure bato is a bush form of Japanese maple. Its leaves are almost laceleaf in appearance with a reddish cast to the new growth that fades to green in summer. The fall color is gold to red. It will reach 6' by 6' at maturity. (Late fall rain)





Shin hikasa is a beautiful variegated dwarf with bright pink, red, and cream spring growth on the second year wood. New growth is a medium green and can be lightly variegated. It is probably a collectors plant only. Fall color is yellow.








Shishi yatsubusa is a dwarf shrub maple with compact stubby growth. Mature size is unknown, but probably under 3' in height. Fall color is yellow orange. (Lion cub)





Shishiohime is a compact, green dwarf maple similar to Murasaki kiyohime, but it is round in habit. The new foliage has orange and red margins in leaves that turn a deep green as they mature. Shishiohime has wonderful orange-red fall foliage. (Dwarf lion)





<u>Sir Happy</u> is a tiny palmatum, possibly the smallest named variety. Spring growth is reddisg soon fading to a medium green. Mature size is unknown, but probably under 1'. Fall color is yellow and orange.





Sode no uchi is a small growing Acer sieboldianum. Mature height is around 10'. Spring foliage is a light green with yellow and red highlights. Fall color is an excellent yellow orange and red. It forms an open airy plant unlike the stiff branching of many of the A. sieboldianum.





Sonya Marie is an extremely slow growing dwarf A. shirasawanum. White variegation is seldom seen. Height will be less than a foot after 10 years. Fall color is a nice orange to red.







<u>Squitty</u> is a dwarf variegated maple. New foliage is a mix of pink, white, and green. It is very similar to Abigail Rose but more upright.



<u>Sunglow</u> is an Acer circinatum with beautiful yellow orange spring foliage, fading to green in the summer. It will form a small tree to about 10', and is best grown in partial shade. Fall color is yellow orange.

<u>Sunny Sister</u> is a semi dwarf A. circinatum. Spring foliage is apricot and peach. It is a smaller grower than its sister, Sunglow. It is probably best grown in partial shade. Fall color is yellow and orange.





<u>Tama hime</u> is a small-leafed, compact dwarf maple with lustrous green foliage. The new foliage is a yellow-green, and the fall color is a fine orange-red. It is more flat-growing and slower than Shishiohime, and will make a good bonsai. (A small globe)





<u>Taro yama</u> is a dwarf green palmatum which holds it's leaves in clusters like the similar Ryuzu. It forms a dense compact dwarf, smaller than Ryuzu. It will form a natural bonsai to about 3 feet. Fall color is scarlet.





<u>Tattoo</u> is a compact green dwarf with overlapping leaves. New growth is a yellow green, maturing to a clean medium green. Mature height is unknown but probably under 2'. Fall color is orange.





<u>Taylor</u> is a semi dwarf variegated palmatum in the butterfly group, probably taller than wide. Foliage has more pink and cream than butterfly. Mature height is unknown, but will most likely reach 5' or 6'.







Tiny Tim is similar in leaf and coloration to Coonara pygmy. It is slower growing and keeps a rounder, more uniform head. At maturity it will be around 4' tall by 6' wide. Fall color is a nice orange and red.





<u>Tokyo yatsubusa</u> is an attractive green dwarf with small leaves and a dense form. It can be compared to Sharps pygmy, but with age it can reach 20 feet. Fall color is yellow and orange.

<u>Tsukomo</u> is a nice upright green dwarf, reaching to about 5 feet, taller than wide. New growth is red, mature to a medium green and finally to a deep green. It is slow growing, but a nice plant. Fall color is a good yellow and orange.





<u>Tsuma gaki</u> has truly outstanding spring foliage with leaves that have yellow-green lobes with purplish-red fingernails. The summer color is a dark green; the fall color is red. Shade is helpful to prolong spring colors. In time Tsuma gaki will form a small tree at 8' in height. (Fence nail)






<u>Usu midori</u> is a small growing palmatum to about 10'. Spring growth is reddish, soon fading to yellow with red edging. Summer heat brings a light yellow green. Fall color is a bright orange and red.





<u>Villa taranto</u> is an excellent linearlobum dwarf. Spring foliage comes out pink then changes to red, then to green, then straw yellow, and finally to a beautiful gold in the fall. Villa Taranto is slower growing than Red Pygmy or Filifera purperea, but worth the wait.





Wabito is a slow growing green fastigiate upright with twisted leaves. It could be considered a semi dwarf version of Mama. Fall color is orange and red. (Lonely person)





<u>WB Hoyt</u> is a witches broom Acer circinatum found at the Hoyt Arboretum in Portland, Oregon. The plant is very similar to Little Gem in form and coloration, leaves are slightly smaller.







<u>Wendy</u> is a semi dwarf palmatum with multicolored foliage. New growth is a pink red fading to a purple red and then to bronze green. Mature height and width are unknown. Fall color is a strong yellow.







<u>Werners Dwarf</u> is a pleasing dwarf maple with bright lime green foliage. It will grow to a globe around 5'. Fall color is orange and red.





<u>Wilsons Pink Dwarf</u> is a beautiful small plant with bright pink and red spring foliage. The fall color is orange and red. The plant is somewhat delicate and will probably require some frost protection, but it is worth the added effort. It will form a round bush approximately 6' at maturity.





<u>Winter Flame</u> is an excellent coral bark dwarf maple that retains all of the characteristics of it of its parent, Sango kaku. It is a better grower than Aka kawa hime or Fjellheim, forming a 6' teardrop-shaped bush in ten years.







Yama gawa is a semi dwarf tree with very narrow linearlobum leaves. It is similar to Koto no ito, but mature trunk and limbs have a corky bark. It will probably grow to 8 to 10'. Fall color is orange and red.







<u>Yama hime</u> is a dwarf red version of the Shindeshojo Japanese maple. It is bright red in the spring with twisted leaves, fading to a mottled reddish green.. It is a better grower than Beni fushigi or Beni komachi and can reach 5' in ten years. (Dwarf mountain)





<u>Yashio</u> is a small round shrub, pink in the spring. It fades to a medium green in the summer. It is a similar plant to Corallinum, but larger growing. Mature height is in the 4' range, as wide as tall. Autumn color is yellow and orange.







Yuri hime sport, as the name implies, is a vigorous sport from Yuri hime. While Yuri hime seldom reaches 3', Yuri hime sport will grow to 6' by 6' in time. Fall color is orange and red.





Yuri hime is one of the smallest of the palmatum varieties. The short annual growth and close bud spacing give the plant the appearance of a covering of feathers. While Yuri hime is not recommended for areas of heavy snow load, it is otherwise surprisingly hardy.
