



Aka shigitatsu sawa is a variegated upright with outstanding coleuslike spring growth. The leaves fade to green with a whitish variegation. Aka shigitatsu sawa makes a strong stocky tree, wider than it is tall. (Red snipe leaving the swamp)





<u>Aizumi nishiki</u> is a nice addition to the Orido nishiki group. Its variegation of pink and cream tends to be brighter than Orido's and occupy the whole leaf. Mature height is unknown. Fall color is orange and red.







Alpenweiss is a variegated upright similar to Higasayama. Excellent cream and red edging shows on leaves of second year wood. This years growth is a medium green. It will form an upright vase to about 15'. Fall color is a bright red.





Alpine Silverthread is an upright variegated palmatum with green veins over a light green leaf. It has more white in the spring leaves and is more upright than the similar Shigitatsu sawa. Mature height is unknown, but probably in the 12-14' range. Fall color is a lemon yellow to orange.





Amber Ghost has wonderful amber and orange spring growth with distinctive dark veins. It will mature as a small tree to about 10'. Summer color is green, with orange red fall color.





<u>Ariadne</u> is a member of the Shigitatsu sawa group. It has orange-pink coleus spring growth with leaves that mature to a maroon red. The fall color is red. At maturity it is a short stocky plant, wider than it is tall, reaching approximately 10'.





Asagi nishiki is a green upright with yellow edging to the irregular twisted leaf. Branches are thin and give the plant an open airy look. Mature height is unknown but probably as wide as tall. Fall color is red. (Yellow Shade)



Asahi zuru is an upright palmatum in the Orido nishiki group.

Variegation tends to be more flecks than the scallop-shape of Orido n.

It is shorter in stature than the others in the group to about 14 to 16'.

Fall color is orange red.

Beni maiko is a variegated upright with brilliant salmon pink spring growth that makes it a showstopper. It fades to a mottled green in summer. It has excellent bright red fall color. It is similar to Shindeshojo or Otome zakura in appearance, but is a smaller grower. Beni maiko will grow to be as wide as it is tall to about 10'. (Red dancing girl)





Beni shichihenge is a similar plant to Butterfly, but the spring variegation is more of an orange-red. It is also more open in its growth when compared to the Butterfly's vase shape. Beni schishihenge is one of our favorites in its class. (Red transformation of lion)








Beni shi en is a narrow upright grower with deeply divided leaves. The leaves are similar to Butterfly in variegation and changeable in color and vary from deep purple to green. The fall color is pinkish to garnetorange. Beni shi en holds its color well even in the south. (Red smoke)





<u>Beni shigitatsu sawa</u> is a variegated upright as wide as tall. Spring foliage is white with green reticulated veins. Leaf tips are red. This may be the same plant as First Ghost.







Beni tsukasa is a variegated upright with brilliant salmon-orange color in spring. This color fades to yellow and then to a green mottled with gold in the summer. Beni tsukasa is somewhat slower growing than Beni maiko or Shindeshojo, but remains very distinctive in spring time. It forms a plant as wide as it is tall, maturing at approximately 14'. (Red administer)









Butterfly is a variegated upright with pink variegation on the edges of its sickle shaped leaves. The variegation fades to cream in the summer, and the fall foliage is a pinkish red. Butterfly forms a distinctive upright, vase-shaped tree.





<u>Carnival</u> is a beautiful Acer campestre with pale pink variegation in the spring. It will fade to white with green centers. It is best planted in the shade to avoid leaf scorch. It will form an oval tree to about 10 to 12'. Fall color is a butter yellow with cream margins.





<u>Coral Magic</u> appears to be a dwarf maple in the Shindeshojo group. Spring growth is a bright salmon pink, darker than the similar Corallinum. Summer leaf fades to green with mottled flecks of variegation. Mature size is unknown.



<u>Coral Pink</u> is a unique small growing palmatum. New growth is a soft pink, mellowing to pastel shades of green and cream. Partial shade is advised for this lovely plant. It will grow to about 8' tall.





<u>Cosmos</u> is a newer variegated palmatum with white and pink variegation over green. Variegation is mostly in the Fu or speckled style. It will grow to a large bush to around 10'. It is probably best grown in afternoon shade.





Cotton Candy is a medium growing palmatum with excellent white and pink variegation. Mature height will probably be in the 10' range, as wide as tall. Bark can have pink striations. to give the plant winter interest. Fall color is yellow and gold.





<u>Deshojo nishiki</u> is a upright cultivar identical to Deshojo but with subtle summer variegation, Variegation appears only after 4 or 5 years, and is yellow to red. Spring color is a bright reddish pink soon fading to a deep green Fall color is a spectacular orange and red.





<u>Deshojo</u> is a variegated upright, spring color is a bright red, but not long lasting. Summer color is a medium green. It is more upright than Shindeshojo or Beni maiko, to about 16'. Fall color is a bright scarlet.





<u>Diane Verkade</u> is a semi weeping palmatum in the Orido nishiki group. It will form a broad tree to about 12 to 14 feet. Fall color is orange and red.





Earthfire is a pretty A. palmatum with beautiful variegated spring foliage. Leaves are deeply divided and a gorgeous pink, red and cream. Height and width are unknown, but probably under 12'. Fall color is a bright scarlet.





<u>Elmwoodii</u> is a variegated upright Japanese maple. Spring growth is a rosy pink. The summer foliage is multicolored with a mix of green, white and red. Eimwoodii grows to be a stocky plant, approximately 12' tall. It is one of the best new variegated maple to come around.





<u>First Ghost</u> is a nice variegated maple with reticulated veins. Spring foliage is creamy white with distinctive darker veins. Leaves are more deeply divided than Shigitatsu sawa and have distinctive wavy leaf margins. This will be a smaller tree to around 10'.







<u>Frosted Purple</u> is a chance seedling from Purple Ghost, It has more pink color in the reticulated leaves than the parent. Fall color is a nice orange to red. It will be a round headed tree in the 14' range.







<u>Fujinami nishiki</u> is a variegated red palmatum. Variegation can be scarce. When seen, variegation covers the entire leaf with a rosy cream. Fall color is orange.





Geisha Gone Wild is a selected mutant from Geisha. Colors range from pink to cream on green to purple leaves. It is a much better grower than Geisha but only to 8 or 10'. Fall color is purple orange.







Ghost Dancer is variegated plant with deep green venation over creamy white. Early spring leaves show red finger nails on the leaf lobes. Fall color is yellow, orange to red. It will be a round headed plant to about 12'.







Gold Reticulated is a variegated palmatum, red and yellow fading to a cream with distinctive green venation. It will be a bush to 8' as wide as tall. Fall color is yellow and orange.





<u>Goshiki Kaede</u> is a variegated A. Buergerianum that forms a small round headed tree. Leaves are smaller than the specie. It is probably best grown with some afternoon shade. Fall color is butter yellow.





Grandma Ghost is an upright variegated palmatum in the Shigitatsu sawa group. Spring foliage is an attractive cream and amber with contrasting veins. Summer color is a yellow green with darker green venation. Fall color is a excellent red.



Hakkan shikin is a rare Acer crataegifolium with white leaves and green and pink sand dusting. Fall color is yellow to red. This is a difficult plant to grow and should be considered a collector plant





<u>Hinode nishiki</u> is a nice red variegated upright palmatum. Base color is a deep red with lighter red variegation. Variegation can be shy, so care must be taken to not over fertilize. Fall color is yellow, orange and red. (Changeable Sunrise)





<u>Hinotori nishiki</u> is a newer member of the Shindeshojo group. Leaves are more deeply divided than Shindeshojo or Beni maiko. Spring color is a apricot pink fading to a mottled green. Mature height will probably be in the 14' to 16' range. Fall color is orange to red.





<u>Hoshi yadori</u> is an Acer pictum with white and yellow variegation. It is a slower growing maple to around 16', as wide as tall. Mature bark is quite rough and distinctive. Fall color is an excellent red and gold. (Painted Maple)







<u>lkandi</u> has pink spring growth changing to green with white variegation. Variegation is on the second year's wood, like Higasayama. Mature height probably in the 14' range. Fall color is orange and red.







<u>llarian</u> is a smaller growing A. palmatum in the Orido nishiki group. Ilarian seems to have more pink and white variegation than most of the group. Fall color is a good orange and red.







<u>lro iro</u> is a smaller growing maple with variegation on the second years growth. It could be thought of as a semi dwarf version of Higasayama. Mature height is unknown, but probably under 10'. Fall color is orange and red.





Itame nibluki is a good up right Japanese maple similar to Ao kanzanshi with subtle Butterflylike variegation.. It matures to a round headed plant around 15' tall rather than the upright vase of Ao kanzanshi. Fall color is a good pink red.







Itame nishiki is a wide growing A. palmatum with subtle butterfly like variegation. It can be compared to Ao kanzanshi, but is a wide grower and not a vase. It is probably the same scion as Itame nibluki. Fall color is a good orange and red.





Julia is an upright palmatum with spring growth a cream with red edging. This soon fades to a medium green with noticeable dark green veins. Fall color is orange and red. Mature height is unknown, but probably under 14'.





<u>Kagero</u> is a small yellow variegated palmatum. It is another variety that can be difficult to retain variegation, so limit fertilizer if possible. Fall color is orange red.







Kagiri nishiki is a cream and green variegated tree similar to Butterfly. The leaves have a little less variegation, but the plant is more rapid and open in its growth than Butterfly. Kagiri nishiki forms a wide vase, approximately 16' tall. (Restricted variegated)





<u>Kara ori nishiki</u> is a small growing bushy upright in the Butterfly group. Variegation is orange fading to cream and mostly restricted to the leaf margins. Fall color is yellow and crimson.







<u>Karasagawa</u> is a variegated upright. It has more flecks in the sickleshaped variegation than the similar Orido nishiki. The second growth is cream colored rather than the pink of Orido nishiki. The fall color is a pleasing orange-red that begins in the variegated portion of the leaves. (Karasa River)







Kasagiyama is similar to Aka shigitatsu sawa in the spring with its coleus patterned leaves. The new growth of Kasagiyama is a bright brick red not the pink of Aka shigitatsu sawa. The plant grows into an open shrub that can reach 12' in height. (Kasagi Mountain)





<u>Kasen nishiki</u> is a variegated upright similar to Orido nishiki, but with a more subtle variegation. This variegation is more irregular, with both sickle shaped markings and spots in pastel pinks and creams. Kasen nishiki will form a small bushy tree approximately 12'. (Flower Fountain)





Ko yuki is a reticulated leafed form of palmatum with leaves deeply divided. The yellow white spring growth has distinctive green venation. Summer leaf is almost white while retaining the green venation. Fall color is a bright orange and red.





<u>Kocho nishiki</u> may be the true name for the common palmatum variety Butterfly. Kocho nishiki grows as a vase with pink variegation on sickle shaped leaves. Variegation fades to a cream color in summer. Fall color is pinkish red. (Variegated Butterfly)





Kocho no mai in a variegated palmatum. It is very similar to Kocho nishiki or Butterfly but the pink and cream variegation is more restricted to the leaf margins. Mature form is unknown. Fall color is a pink red.







Komon nishiki is a small-leaved palmatum with flecked or sand dusted variegation. It is similar to Koshibori nishiki, but with a deeper green foliage. The Komon nishiki has a pleasing orange-red fall color. It makes a small tree at only 12' at maturity. (Small figures on brocade)



Koshibori nishiki is a variegated upright with subtle yellow and pink fleck variegation on its yellow-green foliage. It has a very bright orange fall coloring. From a distance Koshibori nishiki appears to be a small leafed palmatum, and this is what the Japanese would call a "plant of homecoming" as it requires a closer look to appreciate its beauty. (Little dappled variegated or fine dress)



<u>Kotobuki</u> is a variegated plant in the Orido nishiki group. The sickle shaped leaves have more blotches of color than Orido. Mature height is unknown. Fall color is orange and red. (Traditional Japanese theatre)





Ku moi nishiki is an excellent variegated Acer sieboldianum. Spring foliage has bright white variegation flecked throughout the leaf.

Vigorous new growth shows less variegation. The plant should get better with age. Fall color is a bright red.







A. pseudoplatanus <u>Leopoldi</u> is a full sized street tree with creamy pink and yellow variegation. Fall color is a golden yellow. This tree will exceed 40' at maturity,







<u>Lileanne's Jewell</u> appears to be a stable upright variegated bush to about 10'. New foliage is deeply divided with pink variegation on red leaves. Variegation soon turns to a creamy white. Fall color is a deep crimson over pink.





Maiku nishiki is a variegated Acer japonicum similar in leaf to Fernleaf (Acontifolium). Variegation is pink, fading to cream. This plant is probably best grown in partial shade. Fall color is a excellent orange and red.







Manyo no sato is a variegated red palmatum with twisted leaves edged with yellow green. It will grow more as a bush than Beni shi en. Mature height is unknown. Fall color is garnet orange. (The wonder of nature)





<u>Marakumo</u> is a semi dwarf palmatum growing to about 10'. Leaves are a pale green with cream dust flecked variegation. Afternoon shade is recommended for this somewhat delicate scion. Fall color is a soft gold.







Mardi gras is a brightly variegated maple in the Orido nishiki group. It has bright spring growth of pink and white with a little yellow color thrown in. Mature height is unknown. Fall color as a bright orange and red.









Meiho nishiki is a good yellow variegated palmatum. Spring flush is pink, quickly fading to deep green with yellow markings. The yellow variegation fades to a clear cream in summer. Mature height is unknown. Fall foliage is yellow and red.



Mikazuki has a narrow lobed reticulated leaf with margin rolling down. Spring color is a bright pink with green veins maturing to a creamy white. Fall color is a bright orange with green veins. Mature height and form are unknown. (Crescent Moon)



Miwa is a small growing palmatum with subtle green venation on a light green leaf. Spring foliage can be yellow. Mature height is unknown, but probably under 10'. Fall color is an excellent yellow orange and red. (Graceful beauty)






Mocha Rose is a small growing A. macrophyllum with bright pink spring foliage. Leaves fade to mocha in summer. It needs to be planted in area of good air circulation to avoid mildew. Fall color is yellow to orange.






Momoiro woyasan is a dwarf maple with changeable leaf color. Spring color is peach, soon changing to red and then to green. Some leaves have cream sand dusting. Mature height is expected to be in the 5 foot range. Fall color is a bright red. (Peach colored wild mountain)



Meuri no fu is a variegated Acer crataegifolium similar in leaf to Vetchii but of a deeper blue green color. Fall color is yellow orange and red. It will probably need afternoon shade to thrive.





Murasaki shikibu is a variegated maple with twisted foliage in the Orido nishiki group. It is named for a woman poet and novelist from the 10th century Japan. It is a semi dwarf, wider than tall. It is somewhat subject to reversion. Fall color is a bright red.





Naguri nishiki is an Acer mono that has creamy white foliage with a touch of pink in the spring. In the summer it will fade to more green than white. Fall color is yellow and orange.





Nishiki gasane is a yellow and green palmatum similar in appearance to Sagara nishiki. Foliage is a medium green with yellow edging, more pronounced in the spring. Some references consider Sagara nishiki and Nishiki gasane to be the same scion.





<u>Noel</u> is a new variegated sport from Shindeshojo. Spring color is a bright red, leaves maturing to pink and cream variegation on green. Autumn color is a fiery red. Best guess on mature size is about 15'.





Ogi no nagare is a variegated upright to about 12 to 14 feet.

Variegation is in flecks, more noticeable in the spring. It is a similar to plant to the more common Kasen nishiki. Fall color is yellow and orange. (Stream of fans)





Ori zuru is a small bushy variegated tree to about 10'.Leaves are more divided and smaller than the similarly variegated leaf of Karasagawa. Form is similar to Asahi zuru but the leaves are more star shaped. Fall color is red. (Folding Crane)







Oridalike is a wide spreading variegated palmatum. It is almost certainly the same scion as Ogi no nagare. Variegation is subtle flecks of cream and pink and is more noticeable in spring. Fall color is orange and red.

Orido nishiki (Oridono nishiki) is a variegated green upright, whose leaves have a sickle-shaped cream and pink variegation. The second grow is a bright pink, unlike the cream of Karasagawa and the wood of Orido nishiki is often pink or striped with pink. (The rich colored fabric of the master)






Otome zakura is a variegated upright with a brilliant salmon-pink coloring in spring. It is similar to Shindeshojo or Beni maiko, but a taller grower. Otome zakura will reach maturity at approximately 15', forming a tree as wide as it is tall. (Maiden cherry)





<u>Pastel</u> in the spring is a reticulated pink. Black veins become more prevalent as the summer progresses. Fall color is a deep red. Partial shade is probably recommended for this variety.





<u>Peaches and Cream</u> is a member of the coleus or Aka shigitatsu sawa group. The new foliage is greenish-cream and rose-red with distinctive reticulated veins. The fall color is a yellow-orange. Peaches and Cream retains its coleus look longer than Aka shigatsu sawa, especially when planted in partial shade.





<u>Peve multicolor</u> is a beautiful variegated upright palmatum. It is one of the prettiest palmatums in the spring, changing from orange to white to green in the summer. Fall color is orange. Mature height is unknown, but will probably be around 12 to 14'.







<u>Phantom Flame</u> is a variegated maple in the shigitatsu sawa group. Spring foliage is an attractive cream with green venation. The tips of the lobes are a bright red in the fingernail style. It will be a wide growing plant probably under 12'. Fall color is red and orange.





<u>Phoenix</u> is a new variegated upright in the Shindeshojo family. Spring color is a bright pink, fading to a mottled green. It is a smaller grower than Shindeshojo. Fall color is a bright red. (Firebird)





Purple Ghost's spring color is a brick red with black veins. In summer variegated color fades to red. The fall color is garnet. It is a better grower than the similar Kasagiyama. Purple Ghost will grow to be a small tree at 15' tall and 8' wide.





Radiant is a variegated sport from the variety Cosmos., It retains Cosmos' dusting of pink and white variegation on top of green foliage, but the variegation is brighter and the bark striping is quite notable. Mature height and width is unknown.





<u>Rainbow</u> is a beautiful variegated red upright. Base color is a purple red with pink red variegation. Care must be taken to select scion wood with variegation. Fall color is red.

Reticulatum is a variegated upright with dark green venation over a greenish white background on the leaf. Mature height will be in the 10 to 14' range. Reticulatum has the best fall color of any of the Shigitatsu sawa group, bright orange.





Rokugatsuen nishiki is a fast growing member of the Orido nishiki group. Mature height is unknown. Fall color is probably orange red.





Rosa is an exciting new variegated palmatum with pinkish variegation, reminiscent of Ukigumo. It's most striking feature is the pink and yellow striations on the bark. Mature size and fall color are unknown.








Ryumon nishiki is a variegated green upright palmatum with yellow and pink variegation. Variegation is more pronounced in the spring. It will make a small tree to 10 to 12' tall, and as wide. Variegation may be scarce. Fall color is orange to red.





<u>Sagara nishiki</u> is a variegated upright with yellow margins on its deep green leaves. The new growth is a beautiful orange-pink; the fall color is an orange-red. Sagara nishiki is not a big tree, only growing to about 12', and it is best planted in partial shade.





<u>Sawa chidori</u> is a beautiful member of the Aka shigitatsu sawa group. Spring growth is an amber pink with red tips. It fades to green with distinctive white reticulated veins. Fall color is scarlet. (Marsh plover)










<u>Seedling #6</u> is a variegated upright in the Orido nishiki line. Variegation is more of fu, or sand flecks than Orido. Mature height is unknown, but probably in the 16' range. Fall color is a deep red.





<u>Seedling #25</u> is a variegated palmatum with bright pink red variegation edging the new growth. Variegation fades to cream as the leaf matures Leaves are twisted and of various sizes from rather small to full sized. Mature height is unknown..





Shigarami nishiki is a nice new variegated maple. It does not yet show the horizontal branching as Shigarami. Mature height is unknown. Fall color is orange and red.





<u>Shigitatsu sawa</u> is a member of the Aka shigitatsu sawa class of Japanese maples. It has coleus-like spring growth, but the venation is white-over-green rather than pink. It will grow to be a stocky, wide tree eventually reaching 12'.







Shindeshojo is a variegated upright with flaming pink-scarlet leaves in spring. Its summer color is a mottled green, and its fall color is a brilliant red. It has better color than and lasts longer than any flowering tree. Shindeshojo is taller than Beni maiko, but still will only grow to be approximately 12'. (New hands of a young girl)





<u>Shirazz</u> is a similar plant to Geisha Gone Wild: both are bud sports from Geisha. Shirraz may be a little brighter in color and a little more prone to reversion. Some consider them the same scion. Fall color is orange and red.

Shishio Improved has bright pinkish-red spring color, similar to that of Shindeshojo or Beni maiko. It is more red than pink in spring however, but it does fade to the familiar mottled green. The fall color is a scarlet red. Shishio Improved is more upright than Shindeshojo.





Shojo no mai is a nice addition to the Butterfly class of Japanese maples. Its early spring growth has nice orange edging that fades to a cream and pink variegation. Although Shojo no mai is similar in coloration to Beni schishihenge, it is a better grower. (Dancing red face monkey).

Snow Kitten (Code Name Elmer) is a strongly variegated sport from Mikawa yatsubusa. Spring growth is almost pure white. Plant needs to be grown in partial shade to avoid burning. Probably best thought of as a collector plant.



<u>Spring Surprise</u> is a yellow variegated palmatum. Spring growth has blotches of cream and yellow on a medium green leaf. Care must be taken when selecting scion wood to retain the variegation. Fall color is a strong orange.





Taimin nishiki is another excellent variety of variegated red palmatum. Base color is a pink red in spring fading to a brown red in the heat of the summer. Variegation is pink, fading to cream. Care must taken when cutting scionwood to select branches with variegation. Autumn foliage is a nice garnet red.





<u>Taiyo nishiki</u> is a variegated upright maple, similar to Versicolor. It is a strong grower with beautiful orange-red fall foliage. The variegation is less pronounced than in Orido nishiki.





Tequila Sunset is a variegated red upright, variegation rather scarce. When variegation is present, it is a mix of yellow and light pink red. Mature height will probably be in the 14' range. Fall color is orange and red.





<u>Tiger Rose</u> has a coleus-like variegated leaf on a weeping willow shaped tree. It is like a variegated Omurayama. The variegation is rose red in spring, and the fall color is a strong red. Tiger Rose will probably only reach 12' by 12' at maturity.





<u>Tsuru no mai</u> is a an upright variegated palmatum in the Orido nishiki family. Variegation is more white flecks than scallops. Mature height is unknown, but probably in the 14 to 16' range. Autumn color is orange and red.





Tyuetsu nishiki is a variegated upright palmatum. Its variegation is more subtle than Orido nishiki, but it is a beautiful plant. Mature height is unknown. Fall color is orange and red.





<u>Ukigumo</u> is a variegated upright with outstanding white leaf, flecked with green and pink. Shade brings almost a pure white leaf. Ukigumo has pumpkin orange to red fall color and is almost columnar when young. (Floating Clouds)





<u>Uncle Ghost</u> is a small growing palmatum, wider than tall. Spring growth is a bright red, fading to a pink red with darker veins. Fall color is yellow to crimson.





<u>Usugumo</u> or bat wing maple is variegated A. pictum with fine dots of white. Fall color is a butter yellow. It is difficult to propagate and rather slow growing, topping our at about 12'.








<u>Veitchii</u> is a variegated Acer crataegifolium with striking white and pink markings on a triangular leaf. The fall color is a rose-pink to red. It forms a pleasing and dense shrub or small tree. Veitchii grows best in partial shade.





<u>Versicolor</u> is a green variegated palmatum. It shows less variegation than the similar Orido nishiki. It is the fastest and largest grower of the type to about 18'. Fall color is orange and red.






<u>Waka momiji</u> has yellow green foliage with white variegation. Spring coloration flushes with the variegated parts a pink. Fall color is a clear yellow. It will be a larger grower, possibly reaching 20'.





<u>Wako nishiki</u> is a variegated upright Acer buererianum. Spring foliage is a bright pink quickly turning to a white reticulated leaf with distinctive green venation. Mid summer color is a light green with pale yellow to red fall color. Mature height will be in the 15' range, taller than wide. Some shade is recommended for this variety.





<u>Waveleaf</u> is a variegated upright with purple reticulated spring growth and prominent dark venation. Leaves are crinkled to form a wavy appearance. It probably will be a round headed grower to about 12'. Autumn Foliage is a bright orange and red.









<u>Will's Devine</u> is bushy variegated maple, reticulated red new growth over cream and green. Venation remains distinct through out the season. It will grow to a wide spreading bush to about 6'. Fall color is a warm orange.





Yama nishiki has outstanding white, pink, and red variegation on the second year wood. New growth is a bright green. Foliage is similar to Higasayama but much brighter and the plant is more vigorous. Fall color is red. (Changeable mountain)
